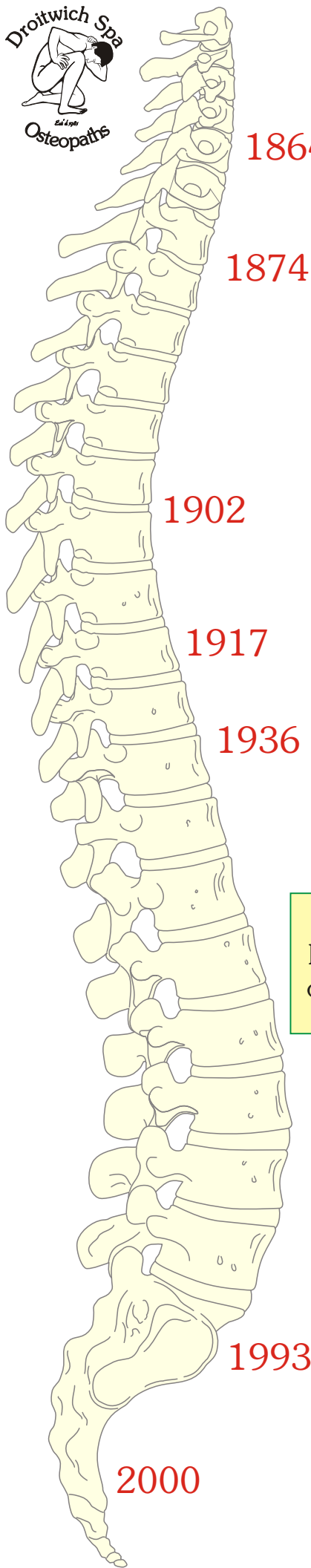




# The History of Osteopathy

British School of Osteopathy Founded

G.C.R.O.  
General Council of Registered Osteopaths  
Formed as a direct result of a failed  
bill for statutory recognition
